Ensure there is a consistent and correct use of tense throughout a piece of writing.


Use a range of high level punctuation including semi-colons, brackets and dashes to indicate parenthesis or mark boundaries.

Use maps, atlases and globes to locate the features studied. Describe and understand the key aspects of climate zones and biomes located across South America.


Complete a study, comparing human and physical geography of the UK's South East and the Manaus region of Brazil.
