

Fractions:

Understand fractions greater than a whole.

Partition a mixed number fraction.

Position a mixed number fraction on a number line.

Compare and order mixed number fractions.

Understand what is meant by an improper fraction.

Convert a mixed number fraction to an improper fraction (and the reverse).

Identify equivalent fraction families (and fractions on a number line).

Add and subtract two or more fractions.

Subtract from whole amounts.

Add and subtract fractions and mixed numbers.

Decimals:

Recognise a tenth as a fraction and as a decimal.

Place tenths on a place value chart and a numberline.

Identify a hundredth as a fraction and a decimal.

Place hundredths on a place value chart.

Divide a 1 and 2 digit number by 100.

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History

Develop an understanding of the training involved to be a Roman soldier as well as the military hierarchy used.

Identify key equipment used by a soldier in battle.
