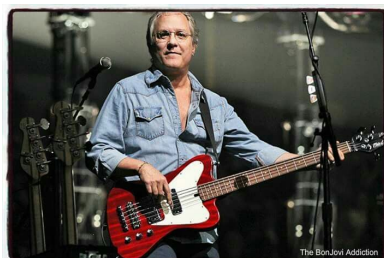
Some of their most famous hits are 'You give love a bad name', 'Livin' on a Prayer' and 'Always'. The band has made 15 albums and sold over 100 million records. They are one of America's most famous rock bands.

Tina Turner is a female rock singer also from the USA. She was born on 26 November 1939. She is widely referred to as the 'queen of rock and roll'.



She began her music career singing with her husband Ike Turner but then became a solo artist. Some of her most famous songs are: 'River Deep, Mountain High', 'Proud Mary' and 'Simply the Best'. She has sold over 100 million records and won many awards.

Rock music has electric guitars, a bass guitar and drums.  
Rock music is usually loud with a strong main beat.

#### Key Vocabulary

<b>Rock music</b>	A style of music with a strong beat and forceful strong singing. Drums and electric guitars feature strongly.
<b>staff notation</b>	Notes written on five lines.
<b>stave</b>	Five lines which notes are written on.
<b>improvise</b>	Create musical ideas quickly, on the spur of the moment.
<b>compose</b>	Write musical ideas down in different forms: written letters, staff notation.
<b>melody</b>	The tune.
<b>appraise</b>	Respond to moods of music and say how it makes you feel.
<b>accuracy</b>	Play notes correctly.
<b>expression</b>	Show feeling when singing or playing.
<b>sharp #</b>	The black keys on a piano keyboard, also known as flats.
<b>composition</b>	The written work you have composed.
