Year 4 clarinet concert 19.3.24

Dear Parents

I am excited to tell you that it is nearly time for your child to perform on their instrument in a short concert on **Tuesday 19 March in the Main Hall.**

There will be two concerts as follows:

- Tiger and Puma at 9:15am
- Jaguar and Leopard at 2:40pm

Please wait outside the year 5/ 6 doors and you will be guided to the main hall by a member of staff.

Parents can book two places per family, via ParentMail > Payment Item > Shop until Monday 18 March at 9am.

The main hall carries sound easily and 60 clarinets together are very loud. Therefore I want to strongly advise you not to bring babies and pre-school children as the concert will be too loud for them and it may cause them to be distressed. Please arrange child care if you can - young children's ears are much more sensitive.

Thank you for helping your child remember their instrument each week. In preparation for the concert, please can all children bring their instrument in on **Monday 18 March** and leave it at school overnight. Unfortunately if your child does forget their instrument they may not be able to perform as I only have a couple of spare clarinets. Please will you help them remember their instrument for our last rehearsal next Tuesday too. Unfortunately, we have had some children who were unable to play in lessons due to their instrument being at home.

Finally, if your child has enjoyed playing clarinet and would like to continue, please do look at the letter I sent recently about lessons with Enfield Music Service (EMS) in the Summer term. It is possible to rent an instrument from them too. Here is a link to the Enfield Music Service website.
