Year 3 Recorder Concert and EMS reminder

Dear Year 3 Parents

Your child has been learning the recorder since October 2019 and these lessons will soon come to an end this term. It is therefore my pleasure to invite you to a short concert to hear all the children play together and show you what they have been learning.

The concert will be on Thursday 2 April at 2.30 pm in the main hall. Two adults per child may attend. Siblings will also be able to attend.

If your child has loaned a school recorder, they should return it after the concert. Children who have their own recorders should also bring these on the day of the concert, but they may also borrow one for the concert if they forget.

On the day, doors will open at 2.20 pm. Please enter the main hall via the Year 5/6 hub door where there will be someone to welcome you.

I am really pleased with the progress the children have made. A number have also regularly attended recorder club at lunchtimes and will be playing the songs they have learnt there too.

If you would like your children to continue learning recorder after Easter, **Enfield Music Service** can do this. The date for enrolling for lessons has been extended to this **Wednesday 11 March**. This is ideal, as the children may also feel inspired after hearing the London Symphony Orchestra, and wish to take up something else, like the trumpet or cello! Ideally, after learning recorder, the flute is the instrument to learn as the fingering is very similar.

Thank you for your support and I do hope you will be able to come to the concert. Please let us know by 3.00 pm on Monday 30 March whether you are able to come to the concert to give us an idea of audience size.
